



The famous match at Shillinglee, Ranji's country estate, between WG's XI aand Ranji's XI. In the picture are Ranji's old cronies WG, MacLaren, Beldam and the artist HS Tuke. 
## 63. AN ENGLAND XI AT HASTINGS, 1901

## 84. CAST IRON DOOR STOP

Large and heavy cast iron door stop, 63cm high.

Designed and cast by Peter Chasseaud in 1976 to mark the Centenary of Test cricket. Number 10 of only 75 castings made.

85. WG GRACE PUB TABLE

Fine example of the WG pub table, c1891. Cast iron with wooden top. This table was from the collection of G Neville Weston, the foremost collector and authority on WG in his day. Registered design number 171737, stamped BICLAN, 60cm diameter x 76cm high. This design was registered and patented by Bennett's Iron Foundry Co, Hyde Road, Ardwick, Manchester at the Public Record Office in 1890 and 1891

We also have on display at the Exhibition an example of the far rarer rectangular shaped WG pub table








